

Course setters Notes

The weather looks perfect for Saturday's event at the Marshall Gold State Park. There will be 34 checkpoints on the course. Each checkpoint will have a multiple choice question to be answered in order to verify that you are at the correct location. There will be no orienteering control flags on this course. Participants can find the checkpoints in any order. Each checkpoint correctly answered will earn 3 points. A 1 point penalty will be given for each minute past the 90 minute race time limit.

Highway 49 bisects the State Park. Please be aware while crossing the highway (do not look at your map while crossing streets). There will be other events happening at the park during our event. Please be aware and respectful while using the park.

All of the checkpoints can be reached using roads and trails. Poison Oak is exploding right now, luckily it can be avoided by staying on trail.

Registration will take place in front of the museum. You can fill out an [online form](#) ahead of time, or register on site. The cost is \$10. Adult \$5. Child.

There is a \$10 State Park parking fee. Please park in the [Sawmill Parking Lot](#). There is a self-pay kiosk in the parking lot. You can pay with a credit card at the museum. The museum is located across the street, and east, from the Sawmill Parking Lot.
