

Rocklin Find Your Way!

Come and explore some of the parks and history of Rocklin, a town whose quarries once provided granite for California State Capital, the San Francisco mint, the infrastructure of the Transcontinental Railroad, and was used to help rebuild San Francisco after the 1906 earthquake. Visit Native American mortar sites, a recreated depot at the site of a stop on the first transcontinental railroad as well as the site of the railroad roundhouse, which was used to service the extra engines that trains needed surmount the Sierras.



With plenty of free nearby parking, shade trees, and public bathrooms, the course is based out of Johnson-Springview Park with runnable, oak-studded, grassy, mostly poison oak free terrain. The course extends north over a pipe bridge into the Sunset Whitney recreation area and also east into downtown Rocklin, the former quarry district. The surfaces will be a mix of dirt, gravel, paved paths, sidewalks and roads.

Score-0 (Scoring orienteering) means you try to find as many of the 32 checkpoints (controls) as you can, answer the question relevant to the checkpoint, and return to the start/finish before the 90 minute time limit runs out. 1 point is earned for each correct answer, but a penalty of -1 will be subtracted for each minute over the 90 minute limit.

Our fees: \$10 for each adult and \$5 for each child or youth (ages 7-18) for non-members and \$8 for adults and \$4 for children or youths for members of GCO or other Orienteering clubs. You can also rent a compass for \$1 and can run individually or as a team. Pencils or pens will be needed to mark your answers. There is no pre-registration, but you can fill out a GCO registration form from our website and bring it, or register at the event. Driving directions:

The assembly area will be near 38.7886, -121.2454. From Interstate 80 traveling northeast to Reno, take the Rocklin Road exit and turn left onto Rocklin Road. Continue until Rocklin Road ends and turn left onto 5th Street. Continue until 5th Street turns left (about 0.38 miles) and turn right into the parking lot (plus the lot extends on dirt west). On street parking as well as several nearby parking lots are available if necessary.
